CTWS GUIDELINES FOR VIRTUAL EXHIBITS

Revised 2/2008, 01/2016, 8/2017, 10/2017, 11/2018, 2/2019, 8/2020

1. ELIGIBILITY OF WORKS:

- a. Paintings must be from your **ORIGINAL IDEAS, SKETCHES or PHOTOS.**
- b. Other photos may be used with the copyright owner's permission. If used, attach the photo to the back of your painting.
- c. **Direct and/or revised copies of artists' sketches, paintings, printed materials, or photos** from any published materials, i.e. internet, magazines, books, or furnished class materials, are NOT acceptable.
- d. Paintings created in a classroom or workshop that reflect the artist's **ORIGINAL IDEAS, SKETCHES, COMPOSITION, or PHOTOS** are acceptable provided furnished class materials are not used, and the teacher has not painted on the painting.
- e. Paintings submitted must be new and completed within the past two years.
- f. Paintings are not eligible if they have been shown at any other **CTWS** local exhibit.

2. MEDIA:

- a. Painting must be 90% water-based media, which can include watercolor, acrylic, casein, gouache, and egg tempera presented in a primarily aqueous manner (no impasto).
- b. Collage will be accepted using any acceptable watercolor paper painted by the artist with approved water media.

3. PAPER:

- a. Paintings should be on paper designed for water media (Yupo and Tyvek permitted).

4. ARTIST STATEMENT: Artists will complete the following information on their exhibit form:

- a. Painting Media Used: 100% _____, or 90% _____, 10% _____,
 - b. Surface Used: _____.
 - c. Painting is My "Original": Idea _____, Sketch _____, Photo _____, or Photo Used by Permission _____.
 - d. Painting was completed within the last two years _____.
- (This information will be provided to the artist judging the exhibit, who will determine if the painting *is acceptable for inclusion in the Awards.*)

5. THE EXHIBIT COMMITTEE:

- a. The Exhibit Committee has full authority to apply rules and regulations for exhibits as well as authority to reject any work not meeting guidelines.

6. LIABILITY:

- a. Due care will be exercised in installing the artist's work to the Virtual Exhibit.
- b. An artist's release form must be signed.
- c. Neither CTWS nor members will be held responsible for copyright infringements.

7. AWARDS:

- a. Virtual Exhibit winners will receive "Merit Award" , as well as a critique for all participants in the exhibit.

8. IDENTIFICATION:

- a. Online brochures may be provided to include **CTWS** information, and identify exhibitors with their contact data.
