**CTWS GUIDELINES FOR MCC
EXHIBITS Revised 2/2008, 01/2016, 10/2017**

- 1. ELIGIBILITY OF WORKS:** Paintings must be from your ORIGINAL IDEAS, SKETCHES, or PHOTOS. Other photos may be used with permission. Direct and/or revised copies of artists' sketches, paintings, printed materials, or photos from any published materials, i.e. magazines, books, or furnished class materials, are not acceptable. Paintings previously shown at The Carleen Bright Arboretum may be submitted for hanging at MCC, but will still follow the requirement of having been painted within the last two years.
- 2. MEDIA:** Painting must be 90% water based media, which can include watercolor, acrylic, casein, gouache, and egg tempera presented in a primarily aqueous manner (no impasto). Collage will be accepted using any acceptable watercolor paper painted by the artist with approved water media.
- 3. PAPER:** Paintings should be on paper designed for water media (Yupo and Tyvek permitted), and canvas will be accepted.
- 4. MATTING:** Paintings, up to and including full sheet size, must be matted with a clean mat. Jumbo or elephant size paintings may be unmatted. Choice of mat color will be decided by the individual artist.
- 5. FRAMING:** Paintings will be framed with a firmly attached TAUT WIRE 1/3 FROM TOP. No other hanging devices are acceptable. Paintings must be under clean glass or Plexiglas. It is recommended that all framed artwork larger than 24" x 30" should be under Plexiglas. Choice of frame will be decided by the individual artist.
- 6. REMOVAL OF PAINTINGS:** Paintings must remain hanging for the duration of the exhibit.
- 7. THE EXHIBIT COMMITTEE:** The Exhibit Committee has full authority to apply rules and regulations for exhibits as well as authority to reject any work not meeting guidelines.
- 8. LIABILITY:** Due care will be exercised in hanging the artist's work. An artist's release form must be signed. Neither CTWS, members, nor the show facility will be held responsible for loss or damage of paintings during the show.
- 9. AWARDS:** MCC Exhibition winners will receive "Merit Award" ribbons, as well as a critique for all participants in the exhibit.
- 10. IDENTIFICATION:** Brochures will be provided in close proximity to Exhibit paintings to include CTWS information, and identify exhibitors with their contact data.
